Within two to four weeks, most of it falls out — a normal, expected phase called shedding, or 'shock loss.' The follicles survive under the skin and lie dormant. New growth begins around three to four months, looks presentable by six to nine, and reaches full density at *twelve to eighteen months*. You fly home looking much as you did — and the transformation happens slowly, at home.

The First-Year Reality — Shedding Is Normal: Most of your transplanted hair sheds within a month of surgery. This is expected, not failure — the follicle stays alive and regrows. Real results take twelve to eighteen months. Any clinic promising a finished look in weeks, or showing 'before-and-afters' taken at three months, is selling a timeline that doesn't exist.

- 5. First Wash & Aftercare**

4. **Beard & Eyebrow Transplants**
The same technique on a different canvas. Angling matters even more here, so surgeon skill is everything.
5. **Crown & Hairline**
The crown swallows grafts because of its whorl pattern. An honest surgeon will tell you whether your donor supply can realistically cover both the hairline and the crown.

Consultation + surgery	Arrive 1 day before; surgery day
Supervised first wash + review	Day 2–3
Recommended total stay	5–7 days

Don't Book a Tight Return: The first 48–72 hours are when grafts are most easily dislodged, and most surgeons clear long-haul flights only from day five to seven — after the first wash and a follow-up. Build in the buffer, and remember the real change happens back home, over a year.
